How long does a coin last?

Most coins can circulate for about 25 years before they become too worn to be used anymore. That's a long time when you consider that the average dollar only lasts for 18 months.

What happens to worn out coins?

The United States Mint recycles worn-out coins it receives from a Federal Reserve Bank. The Mint then sends any usable metal that's recovered to a fabricator, who turns it into coinage strips for new coins.
